This half term we'll be thinking about forces and magnetism in science alongside volcanoes and earthquakes in Geography. The earth is constantly moving, but what are the forces that act upon it? We'll also explore what magnetism is and how that affects our earth too.

Below are some suggestions of things you could do at home. You can pick one or do as many as you like and you might have some super ideas of your own too!



Make your own exploding volcano at home.



Make a model of how fault lines work and how forces work upon them.



Create a top trumps game with countries of Europe. Include flags, capital cities, population and number of volcanoes.



Find out which surfaces cause the most friction by setting up a ramp experiment with cars.



Can you make up a dance in which you are being pushed and pulled by an invisible magnet?



Try dipping metal objects (like paperclips) in paint and then pulling them around on paper with a magnet to create a wild painting!



On a map label as many capital cities as you can.



Explore how many paperclips a magnet can pick up, if you have more than one magnet is there a difference?



We will explore how forces and magnets affect everything. How is gravity is affected by forces.






